## **INVITATION TO TENDER**

1.1 The National Mining Corporation (NAMICO) is a State Corporation established under the Mining Act, 2016, Mining (State participation) Regulations, 2017 and the Mining (Strategic Minerals) Regulations 2017 as to:

- i) Engage in strategic mineral prospecting, mining, and any other activities related strategic minerals;
- ii) Engage in mineral prospecting and mining, and any other related activities;
- iii) Invest on behalf of the national government;
- iv) Acquire by agreement or hold interests in any undertaking, enterprise or project associated with the exploration, prospecting and mining;
- v) Acquire shares or interest in any firm, company or other body of persons, whether corporate or unincorporated, which is engaged in the mining, prospecting, refining, grading, producing, cutting, processing, buying, selling or marketing of minerals; and
- vi) Carry on its business, operations and activities whether as a principal-agent, contractor or otherwise, and either alone or in conjunction with any other persons, firms or bodies corporate.

1.2 The Corporation invites sealed bids from interested candidates for the disposal of **COPPER ORE** on “AS IS WHERE IS BASIS”.

1.3 All interested bidders are advised to visit the indicated location (**GODOWN 45, KHINS BUSINESS PARK AT ATHI RIVER**) to carry out their own assessment before submitting their final bids. Viewing of the items can be done by interested bidders in their respective location by arrangement with the officer in charge of the regional/ liaison office where the items are located.

1.4 Interested eligible candidates may obtain further information from and inspect the tender documents at the Supply Chain Office, situated at the National Mining Corporation Headquarters on 4th Floor, KWFT Building Centre, Upper Hill during normal working hours.

## **SECTION I - INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS**

### **1 Eligible Tenderers**

1.1 This Invitation for Tenders is open to all tenderers eligible as described in the Appendix to instructions to tenderers. 1.2 Tenderers shall be under a declaration of in eligibility for corrupt or fraudulent practices

1.3 The tenders are open to all eligible persons.

### **2. Cost of Tendering**

2.1 The tenderer shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its tender, and the Procuring Entity, will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the tendering process.

2.2 The Procuring Entity shall allow the tenderer to review the tender document and the goods to be sold free of charge before tendering.

### **3. The Tender Document**

3.1 The tender document comprises the documents listed below and any addenda issued in accordance with clause 2.5 of these instructions to tenderers.

- i) Invitation to tender, ii) Instructions to tenderers,
- iii) Schedule of items and Prices,
- iv) Conditions of Tender, v) Form of tender, vi) Confidential Business Questionnaire Form, vii) Tender Commitment Declaration Form.

2.1 The tenderer is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the tender documents. Failure to meet all the requirements of the tender will be at the tenderer's risk and may result in the rejection of its tender.

#### **4 Clarification of Documents**

4.1 A prospective tenderer requiring any clarification of the tender document may notify the Procuring Entity in writing or by post at the entity's address indicated in the Invitation for tenders. The Procuring Entity will respond in writing to any request for clarification of the tender documents, which it receives not later than three (3) days prior to the deadline for the submission of tenders, prescribed by the Procuring Entity. Written copies of the Procuring Entity's response (including an explanation of the query but without identifying the source of inquiry) will be sent to all prospective tenderers that have received the tender document.

4.2 Clarification of tenders shall be requested by the tenderer to be received by the Procuring Entity not later than 3 days prior to the deadline for submission of tenders.

4.3 The Procuring Entity shall reply to any clarifications sought by the tenderer within 2 days of receiving the request to enable the tenderer to make timely submission of its tender.

#### **5 Amendment of Documents**

5.1 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of tenders, the Procuring Entity, may for any reasons, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective tenderer, modify the tender documents by amendment.

5.2 All prospective candidates that have received the tender documents will be notified of the amendment in writing or by post and will be binding on them.

5.3 In order to allow prospective tenderers reasonable time in which to take the amendment into account in preparing their tenders, the Procuring Entity, at its discretion, may extend the deadline for the submission of tenders.

#### **6 Tender Prices and Currencies**

6.1 The tenderer shall indicate on the appropriate Price Schedule the unit prices and total tender price of the item it proposes to purchase under the contract.

6.2 Prices quoted by the tenderer shall be fixed during the tender validity period and not subject to variation on any account. A tender submitted with an adjustable price quotation will be treated as non-responsive and will be rejected.

6.3 The Price quoted shall be in Kenya Shillings.

#### **7 Tender deposit**

7.1 The tenderer shall put a deposit for every item tendered for in the amount indicated in the schedule of items and prices, to the Bank account indicated in Section III - Schedule of Items and Prices.

7.2 Failure to put the required deposit for any item tendered for will lead to disqualification of the tender for the item.

7.3 Unsuccessful Tenderer's tender deposit will be discharged or returned as promptly as possible but not later than Seven (7) days after the expiration of the period of tender validity prescribed by the Procuring Entity.

7.4 The successful Tenderer's tender deposit will be credited to his tender price so that it forms part of the amount of the tender and the tender will be required to pay the tender price less the deposit security.

7.5 The tender deposit shall be forfeited:

- a) If a tenderer withdraws its tender during the period of tender validity specified by the Procuring Entity.
- b) In the case of a successful tenderer, if the tenderer fails to pay the balance of the tender price.

## **8 Validity of Tenders**

8.1 Tenders shall remain valid for 60 days or as specified in the appendix to instruction to tenderers after date of tender opening prescribed by the Procuring Entity, pursuant to paragraph 2.10. Tender valid for a shorter period shall be rejected by the Procuring Entity as non-responsive.

8.2 In exceptional circumstances, the Procuring Entity may solicit the Tenderer's consent to an extension of the period of validity. The request and the responses there to shall be made in writing. The tender deposit provided under paragraph 2.7 shall also be suitably extended. A tenderer may refuse the request without forfeiting its tender deposit. A tenderer granting the request will not be required nor permitted to modify its tender.

## **9. Viewing of Tender Items**

9.1 Prospective tenders are advised to view the items to be sold before tendering.

This will enable them to arrive at the most reasonable and competitive tenders. Tenders are based on "AS WHERE IT IS AND THE CONDITION IT IS IN" and the conditions of the items are not guaranteed or warranted by the seller.

## **10. Sealing and Marking of Tenders**

10.1 The Tenderer shall deliver the Tender in a single, sealed envelope bearing the name and Reference number of the Tender, addressed to the Procuring Entity and a warning not to open before the time and date for Tender opening date. Within the single outer envelope the Tenderer shall place another sealed envelope containing the list of and prices of the items tendered for and addressed as follows.

- a) Bear the name and address (including telephone number and email) of the Tenderer;
- b) Bear the name and Reference number of the Tender;
- c) Bear the name and address of the Procuring Entity; and

10.2 If all envelopes are not sealed and marked as required, the *Procuring Entity* will assume no responsibility for the misplacement or premature opening of the Tender, or failure to contact the tenderer in case of advice on the status of the tender or refund of deposit. Tenders that are misplaced or opened prematurely will not be accepted.

## **11. Deadline for Submission of Tenders**

Tenders must be received by the Procuring Entity at the address specified not later than **08<sup>th</sup> June 2026 at 11.00 AM.**

The Procuring Entity may, at its discretion, extend this deadline for the submission of tenders by amending the tender documents in accordance with paragraph 2.5. in which case all rights and obligations of the Procuring

Entity and tenderers previously subject to the deadline will thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.

## **12. Modification of tenders**

12.1 The tenderer may modify or withdraw its tender after the tender's submission, provided that written notice of the modification, including substitution or withdrawal of the tenders, is received by the Procuring Entity prior to the deadline prescribed for submission of tenders.

12.2 The Tenderer's modification or withdrawal notice shall be prepared, sealed, marked, and dispatched in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 2.9.1. A withdrawal notice may also be sent by fax or email but followed by a signed confirmation copy, post marked not later than the deadline for submission of tenders.

12.2 No tender may be modified after the deadline for submission of tenders **13**

## **Withdrawals and tenders**

13.1 No tender may be withdrawn in the interval between the deadline for submission of tenders and the expiration of the period of tender validity specified by the tenderer. Withdrawal of a tender during this interval may result in the tenderer's forfeiture of its tender deposit, pursuant to paragraph 2.7.5

## **14 Opening of Tenders**

14.1 The Procuring Entity will open all tenders in the presence of tenderers' representatives who choose to attend. The tenderers or representatives who are present shall sign a register evidencing their attendance.

14.2 The tenderers' names, tender modifications or withdrawals, tender prices, and the presence or absence of requisite tender deposit and such other details as the Procuring Entity, at its discretion, may consider appropriate, will be announced at the opening.

14.3 The Procuring Entity will prepare minutes of the tender opening. **15 Clarification of tenders**

15.1 To assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of tenders the Procuring Entity may, at its discretion, ask the tenderer for a clarification of its tender. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing, and no change in the prices or substance of the tender shall be sought, offered, or permitted.

15.3 Any effort by the tenderer to influence the Procuring Entity in the Procuring Entity's tender evaluation, tender comparison or contract award decisions may result in the rejection of the tenderers' tender. **16 Evaluation and Comparison of Tenders**

16.1 The Procuring Entity will examine the tenders to determine whether they are complete, whether the tenderer has fulfilled the eligibility criteria, whether any computation errors have been made, whether required deposits have been furnished, whether documents have been properly signed and whether the tenders are generally in order. After examination a tender that will be determined to be substantially non-responsive, will be rejected by the Procuring Entity.

16.2 Provided that the Tender is substantially responsive, the Procuring Entity shall handle errors on the following basis:

- a) Any error detected if considered a major deviation that affects the substance of the tender, shall lead to disqualification of the tender as non-responsive.
- b) Any errors in the submitted tender arising from a miscalculation of unit price, quantity, subtotal and total bid price shall be considered as a major deviation that affects the substance of the tender and shall lead to disqualification of the tender as non-responsive .and
- c) If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail.

16.3 The Procuring Entity will evaluate and compare the tenders, which have been determined to be substantially responsive.

16.4 The tender evaluation committee shall evaluate the tender within 30 days of the validity period from the date of opening the tender.

### **17 Award Criteria**

17.1 The Procuring Entity will award the contract to the successful tenderer(s) whose tender has been determined to be substantially responsive and has been determined to be the highest tendered price, subject to the reserve price.

### **18 Notification of Intention to enter into a Contract/Notification of Award**

18.3 Prior to the expiration of the period of tender validity, the Procuring Entity will notify the successful tenderer in writing that its tender has been accepted.

18.4 Simultaneously the other tenderers shall be notified that their tenders have been unsuccessful.

### **18 Canvassing/Contacting the Procuring Entity**

18.1 No tenderer shall contact the Procuring Entity on any matter relating to its tender, from the time of the tender opening to the time the contract is awarded.

18.2 Any effort by a tenderer to influence the Procuring Entity in its decisions on tender evaluation, tender comparison, or contract award may result in the rejection of the tenderer's tender.
